

- Mahwah resident Rena Rothman has been named this year's winner of the prestigious Melvin Jones Fellowship Award by the Saddle River Valley Lions Club.


Established in 1973 by Lions International, the Melvin Jones Fellowship was created in honor of the organization's founder and is the highest honor the club can bestow upon one of its members.


